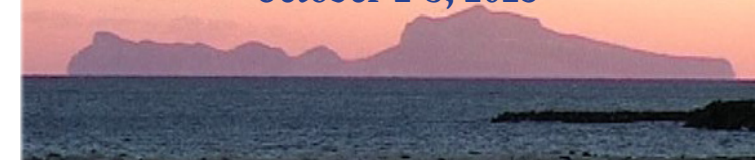

Junior category :

Selection online

The winners of the absolute first prize in each category will perform in the winners’ concert to be held in Capri and Anacapri on the gala evening.

Senior category:

Online selection: Prelude and fugue from The Well-tempered Clavier by J.S. Bach (mandatory) and free programme of minimum 20 minutes, maximum 30 minutes
Finals in Anacapri on October 4 2023, free programme (minimum 40 minutes, maximum 45 minutes)

Winners concert and Awards ceremony to take place on October 5, 2023, in Anacapri

Section II – Violino

Junior category :

Selection online

The winners of the absolute first prize in each category will perform in the winners’ concert to be held in Capri and Anacapri on the gala evening.

Senior Category:

Online selection: one musical piece to be freely chosen among Bach’s Sonatas and Partitas for solo violin (mandatory), and free programme of minimum 20 minutes, maximum 30 minutes

Finals in Capri Palazzo Cerio, on October 2, 2023, free programme (minimum 40 minutes, maximum 45 minutes)

Winners concert and Awards ceremony to take place on October 3, 2023, in Capri

For both sections only up to 6 competitors will be admitted to the finals. Tracks played for the online selection cannot be repeated during the finals

5 - HOW TO PARTICIPATE

The admission request form provided by the organizing entity must be filled out and sent to fondazioneapolitano@gmail.com by September 20, 2023, with a link to the performance required for the online selection

d) The video must be recorded from an angle that doesn’t change, no edits are allowed and the performer has to be clearly visible. Once uploaded as “unlisted video” on YouTube platform the link of the video must be submitted to the secretariat of the competition together with identity document and a short curriculum vitae

6 - COMMON RULES

Candidates admitted to the finals must present themselves at the audition with ID and 3 copies of sheet music. Performances will be in alphabetical order, starting with the letter drawn before the start of the selection. Contestants who do not show up for roll call and who arrive late for justified reasons will be admitted to the rehearsal at the end of the performances for the category or section they belong to. All performances will be held in the presence of the audience. For violinists, the organization will provide an accompanying pianist at a cost of 80 euros.

The judgment of the Juries is final. They shall have the right to shorten the duration of the performances and, if necessary, to replay them. Each juror will make a written declaration under his or her own responsibility that he or she has no relationship of kinship or affinity, nor has he or she had any continuous teaching relationship with the competitors in the last two years. If this is the case, the juror will refrain from judging for his or her student. Contestants are required to indicate the name of their
